

Example of an **insufficiently filled out literature search form** with little number of key words which are the same as the topic title. These key words are too broad; therefore, the literature search results will be too general. If the applicant must create a work detailing the topic, they won't find appropriate material in the literature search results.

From this kind of a form, we are unable to assume what kind of campaign is the focus of the work (e.g., medial campaign), or if we should focus on a certain type of media, e.g., print, TV, radio, etc. This topic could be centered around a specific country, region, the whole world, or individual political parties, which we are also unable to figure out.
